Working with the programs team of CHMR-FM and its community partner, Association for New Canadians, the Executive Producer will be responsible for delivering 25 x 55-minute shows per year, to air on CHMR-FM and in a podcast format.

*Key Responsibilities:*

- Story generation
- Field Reporting: contacting interviewees, conducting interviews, recording interviews
- Editing audio
- Producing news stories and special audio features
- Writing scripts and website content, as necessary

- Knowledge of, and interest in promoting, cultural diversity, anti-racism, workplace inclusion, and newcomer integration
- Working knowledge of audio editing software

- Experience mixing for radio shows, including jingles, program cues, etc.
